

ZEISS Scholarship Program

Official Scholarship Rules and Regulations 2021-2022

- 1. THERE IS NO FEE AND NO OBLIGATIONS NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN THIS SCHOLARSHIP. ENTRIES ARE LIMITED TO ONE PER STUDENT. ALL FEDERAL, STATE, LOCAL, AND MUNICIPAL LAWS AND REGULATIONS APPLY. VOID WHERE PROHIBITED.**

2. Eligibility

The ZEISS IQS Academic Scholarship Program is open only to legal residents of the fifty (50) United States and the District of Columbia, who currently reside in the U.S., and who are at least eighteen (18) years of age or older on the date of entry. Employees of Carl Zeiss Industrial Metrology, LLC (“**ZEISS**”), its affiliated companies, participating sponsors, sales agencies, suppliers, sales representatives, distributors, resellers, subsidiaries, advertisers, advertising agencies, public relations agencies, and other companies associated with the promotion of the scholarship, and their respective parents, subsidiaries, affiliates, advertising and promotion agencies, as well as the immediate family (spouse, parents, siblings, and children) and household members of each such employee are not eligible to apply or win the scholarship. Applicants must be an active part-time or full-time student currently enrolled in or in an accredited institution. Applicant must be enrolled full or part-time at an accredited institution between August 1st, 2021 and May 31st, 2022. Applicants must be currently enrolled in a metrology, machining, or engineering program.

6. Scholarship Selection and Announcement

A team of judges will review all entries after the deadline of **February 28, 2022**. Each entry will be judged on the creativity, knowledge of metrology, and how well they demonstrated their knowledge. The Academic Program Scholarship winners will be selected by **Friday, March 11, 2022** (the “**Scholarship Selection and Announcement**”). Closing date for entry will be **February 28, 2022** at 11:59:59pm CST. Entries that are submitted after the Scholarship Deadline will be disqualified. The winner will be notified by email and/or letter within 90 days of the closing date. If the winner cannot be contacted or does not claim the prize within 14 days of notification, the Sponsor reserves the right to withdraw the prize from the winner and pick a replacement winner.

7. How to Enter

In order to qualify, applicants must complete the required documentation of the ZEISS IQS Academic Scholarship Program Application (the “**Application**”) found at www.zeiss.com/metrology/campaigns/zeiss-scholarship.html by **Friday, December 31st, 2021** at 11:59:59 pm CST. Each student must complete all required fields listed on the Application online form. The applicant must also submit a final video (the “**Video**”) designating themselves and representing institution. 8. Distribution of Awards

Six winning (6) students will be awarded a one-time, \$1,000 scholarship (per student) for qualified expenses, including undergraduate tuition, fees, books, and on-campus room and board for the 2021-2022 school year. Scholarships awarded to all students are to be applied to qualified expenses, including undergraduate tuition, fees, books, and on-campus room and board for the 2021-2022 school year. If any winner cannot accept the scholarship as stated for any reason, the scholarship will be forfeited and awarded to an alternate winner. No scholarship transfers, assignments, cash equivalents or substitutions will be allowed. Funds are provided directly by Carl Zeiss Industrial Metrology, LLC Payments are issued by Carl Zeiss Industrial Metrology, LLC,

made payable to the student and mailed after March 31, 2022. No cash alternative to the prizes will be offered. The awards are not transferable. Awards are subject to availability and Carl Zeiss Industrial Metrology, LLC reserves the right to substitute any prize with another of equivalent value without giving notice. Carl Zeiss Industrial Metrology, LLC's decision in respect of all matters to do with the competition will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.

9. Responsibilities of Recipients

The recipient must be actively enrolled full or part-time as an undergraduate freshman, sophomore, junior, or senior at some time between Summer 2021-Spring 2022 and for an entire academic semester without interruption, barring illness, emergency, or military service. It is the recipient's responsibility to verify receipt of funds with their designated institution and notify Carl Zeiss Industrial Metrology, LLC should the award check not arrive on or after 30 days from the issue date.

10. Institution Approval

The institution must be accredited and listed on the official website of the U.S. Department of Education. All school transfers are subject to accreditation approval. Applicants must also receive proper approval from their institution for use of the institution's equipment and resources.

11. Disqualification

The Sponsor may disqualify any individual it finds to be tampering with the entry application or the operation of the Scholarship; to be acting in violation of the Official Scholarship Rules and Regulations, by cheating, hacking, deception, or other unfair playing practices (including the use of automated entry programs), or to be acting in a non-sportsmanlike or disruptive manner, or with intent to annoy, abuse, threaten or harass the Sponsor or any other person.

12. General Conditions

In the event that the operation, security, or administration of the Scholarship is impaired in any way for any reason, including, but not limited to fraud, virus, bug, worm, unauthorized human intervention, or other technical problem, or in the event the Scholarship is unable to run as planned for any other reason, as determined by the Sponsor in its sole discretion, the Sponsor may, in its sole discretion, either (a) suspend the Scholarship to address the impairment and then resume the Scholarship in a manner that best conforms to the spirit of these Official Scholarship Rules and Regulations or (b) terminate the Scholarship and, in the event of termination, award the scholarship among eligible, non-suspect entries received up to the time of the impairment. The Sponsor reserves the right in its sole discretion to disqualify any individual it finds to be tampering with the entry process or the operation of the Scholarship or to be acting in violation of these Official Scholarship Rules and Regulations or in an unsportsmanlike or disruptive manner.

In order to claim the award, each student will be required to electronically sign and submit a Declaration of Compliance within seven (7) days of the date of the initial email notification was sent. In signing the Declaration of Compliance, the winner acknowledges they give the Sponsor permission to include a photo of the student in social media posts about the Scholarship. The winner agrees to the use of the student's name and image in any publicity material. Any personal data relating to the winner or any other applicants will be used solely in accordance with current federal and state data protection legislation and will not be disclosed to a third party without the applicant's prior consent.

If any other funds pay entirely the tuition, fees, books, and on-campus room and board for the student's 2021-2022 school year, the student is no longer eligible to receive this scholarship and will forfeit the award.
