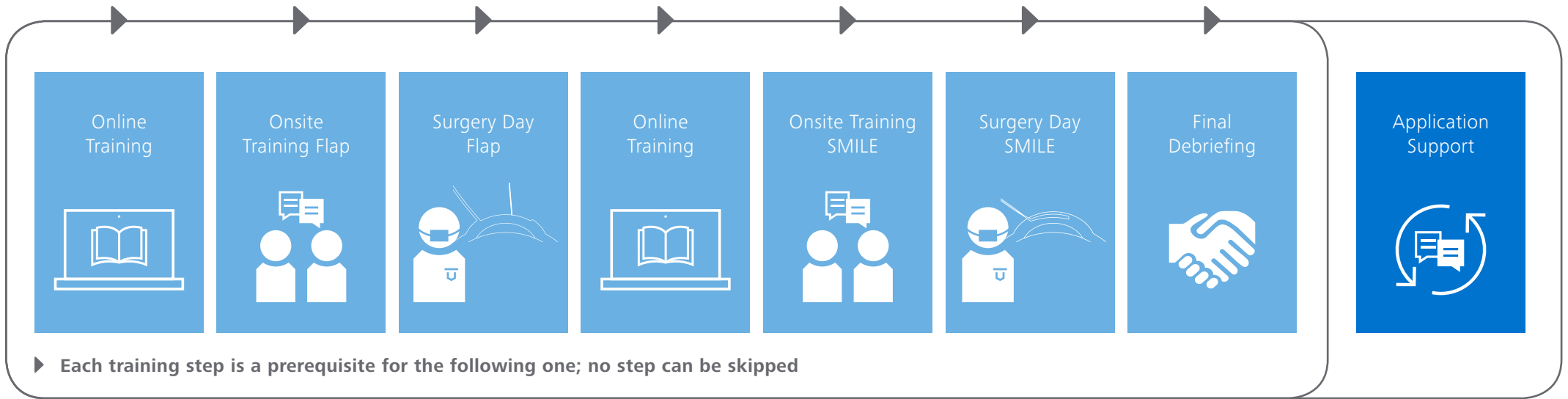


SMILE Onboarding Process



Online Training

- Online training for VisuMax® basics and flaps
- Suitable for MD, OD, and staff
- Test questions for self-audit

Onsite Training Flap

- Theory session
- Hands-on training
- Wet labs (min. 5 eyes each surgeon)
- First flap surgeries (min. 6 eyes each surgeon)
- Follow-up of outcomes from first surgeries

Flap Surgeries

- Continuous application support
- Min. 50 eyes each surgeon
- Clinical Application Specialist (CAS) decides to proceed with SMILE® training

Online Training

- Online training for SMILE® application
- Suitable for MD, OD, and staff
- Contains several surgical videos
- Test questions for self-audit

Onsite Training SMILE

- Theory session
- Hands-on
- Wet labs (min. 5 eyes each surgeon)
- First SMILE® surgeries (min. 6 eyes each surgeon)
- Follow-up of outcomes from first surgeries

Following SMILE Surgeries

- Continuous training and support to improve overall SMILE® performance
- Clinical Application Specialist (CAS) decides if clinical endpoints are reached

Final Debriefing

- Meeting MD, OD, and staff
- Evaluation of confidence level and clinical results
- Decision on end of initial application training process or additional training sessions

Continuous Application Support

- Frequent application support visits
